- **February 18, 9:50 am – Cindy Mildenberger**

Cindy has been a Controls Engineer at P&R Industries for 30 years. She frequently travels internationally for her job. As an engineer and scientist, she resisted the spiritual world until she was introduced to Biblical Storytelling (which she has shared several times in DPC worship).

Windsor has been a Social Studies teacher for 34 years in the RCSD. Having migrated from the Jim Crow south during the Great Migration of the 1950s, his parents brought with them a deep tradition of spirituality. His maternal grandmother was an Evangelist and his uncle was a minister in The Church of Christ. The 1960's counter culture and Windsor's year spent as a combat soldier in Vietnam were a serious challenge to his faith. Marriage and fatherhood brought him to DPC and have deepened his faith-based convictions.
